# Wichita APICS Education – March 2015

#### **NEW CSCP Eligibility Requirements**

To be eligible for the APICS CSCP, a candidate must meet one of the following criteria:

- Bachelor's degree\*, or
- CPIM, CFPIM, CIRM, SCOR-P, C.P.M., CSM or CPSM designations, or
- 3 years of related business experience

\*APICS defines the international equivalent of a Bachelor's degree as the level of study that would qualify an individual for a graduate program in the country where the undergraduate degree was earned. The CSCP committee recently approved changes to the CSCP eligibility requirements. These changes were posted on the APICS website and in the CSCP bulletins at the end of January. Candidates who were previously denied eligibility, but may now qualify should have been contacted of the changes by email in the beginning of February.
