I will say a phrase of the Scripture in the King James version, followed by the same phrase in the Holman Christian Standard Bible and the NIV. It may be any part, the opening, the closing or the middle part. The participant must correctly locate the verse and place his index finger on the verse before he steps forward. When called upon, he must be able to read the entire verse and state the correct Scripture reference.
